

FR. MARK'S NOTES

June 20 and the "Unlocked Conference"

While it may not seem to be such, what will happen here this Tuesday, June 20, at OMOS may be the start of a new beginning for our parish, many other parishes, and even our diocese. The International group <u>Divine Renovation</u> will be here to present to the leadership of the Diocese "Unlocked." This one-day regional event ponders the future of our churches as we go forward into the new millennium. As I look around the diocese, I see little sparks turning into fires of growth and new life in the Spirit. Alpha has expanded to other parishes here in Johnstown and in other parishes in Altoona as well, the Cursillo movement is growing, and 200 people showed up for a Life in the Spirit Seminar in Altoona—signs of growth and new life in our Local Church.

We have invited the leadership of many of our parishes in Altoona-Johnstown to come together this Tuesday, June 20, and ponder the keys that will "Unlock" our parishes so they can become these "hot spots' of new life and prayer where people can go, be welcomed, and grow in their life of Faith. The three keys we will present are evangelization, leadership, and the Holy Spirit. These are the keys that will bring us to a new future together. Many of you have generously volunteered to be part of our day here, and I am hopeful good things will be happening for us and the parishes that have chosen to join us in this day of renewal for our diocese.

So, I ask you for your prayers that our "Unlocked Conference" will be beneficial. We will probably be small in number, but hopefully, seeds will be planted, and a new Church will emerge and bear much fruit. Next week I'll share some thoughts on how the day went. Again, keep us in prayer as we ponder a new future together.
