

## Easter Season and Confirmation and Holy Communion

Confirmation for our young adults and First Holy Communion for our 2<sup>nd</sup> graders are coming up. And they need your prayers. So, beginning this week, we will have their names in a basket in the back of the Church. So, grab a name of two and pray for those people during the Easter season. Pray for the Confirmation candidates that they see this as a big step in their growth as Christians and not a graduation. Pray that this is a step into a deeper relationship with Jesus for them. Think of Paul and the highly religious person who meets Jesus on the road to Damascus and is immediately baptized. What he merely baptized, or did he live his Baptism?
