

FR. MARK'S NOTES

A Class for "All Seekers and Questioners: or Those Who Feel Unwelcomed"

We have been talking about our offerings for Adult Faith Formation this summer. And, given our recent "Follow Your Faith" discussions, I was wondering if anyone would come if I offered a class for those who are wondering, curious, have a ton of questions, and just in general inquiring, or for whatever reason, feel unwelcomed. This class will be for agnostic seekers, Christian seekers, or for those who don't even know where they fall on that spectrum. As we discussed last week, the various steps that Sherry Weddell calls "pre-faith," being curious and asking questions is a huge part of the conversion process. All of us go through these stages, and are on a incredible journey to find the truth and the meaning of life. So, of course, I will offer the Christian view of all of that. But also, I hope to listen hard to what you have to say about — anything and everything.

So, my question to all of you is simply this? (And you can tell me when you see me.) **Do you think anyone will come? DO YOU THINK YOU MIGHT COME?** Either because I will be conducting the process, or they simply won't feel welcomed, or for some other reason I can't think of right now. It's my thought right now to give it a try. What do you think?
