

## FR. MARK'S NOTES

#### **SACRAMENT OF PENANCE**

As I mentioned last week, we will not have our usual Penance Service, but we will offer times for the sacrament – especially Monday and Tuesday, March 20 and 21, from 6—7:30 pm each evening. Priests will be scattered throughout the Church. We will have hospitality ministers direct you and let you know where the priests are stationed, and you will know when the priests are available. Of course, I will also have Confessions at the usual times throughout Lent. More on that later. Personally, this sacrament is very important in my life. I need to celebrate it often and hear those words of forgiveness. I hope we provide enough opportunities for you to celebrate this great sacrament of forgiveness.

Folks, let's stop putting off confession. Let's make every effort to get there. Parents, please, please get here yourself, AND PLEASE, PLEASE, BRING YOUR KIDS!! PLEASE. Stop the merry-go-round of activities for one hour and do this very important thing.

#### **2023 CATHOLIC MINISTRIES DRIVE**

I think you finally got your letter for the Catholic Ministry Drive. Again, the entire focus of this initiative is different, as it has been for the last few years. Let me explain: The monies collected by this new "Drive" (I'll call it the 2023 CMD) will go exclusively to: caring for the poor, strengthening families, nurturing youth, and formation of clergy and laity, and not to the Diocesan general budget, which is where most of it went before. Not most, but 100% of all funding will go to these vital ministries. Many of those things fit our mission statement. Therefore, the funding will go to ministries that impact people in parishes and communities. That is very different from how the old ACA worked.

Also, the diocese will be doing everything it can to keep administrative expenses to a minimum, 2%, while doing everything it can to keep these vital ministries that we support sustained and viable.

Again, our target amount here at OMOS is \$92,000; for St. Michael's, the target it's \$7,210. That shouldn't freak us out. If we all give a little –me too, all will be well. Now, if we all give a little, this can be light work for us. A few years ago, we hit 45% participation and met the goal. What would happen if we hit 100%? We should try to do what we can to hit that target amount. Again, with this new approach, the diocese is trying to keep ministries that affect everyday people going while also keeping the Diocese financially solvent.

More later, but thank you for reading this, and I simply ask you to pray and keep an open heart as you discern, as members of the Church of Altoona-Johnstown, how you may enter this financial commitment to your local Church.

#### **SAVE THE DATE: JUNE 20**

We have been asked by the international organization Divine Renovation to sponsor a daylong event titled "Unlocked." We are to "unlock our parishes from simply hunkering down and maintaining to parishes that embrace the mission of the Gospel. Instead, we want to unlock using the keys of Evangelization, Leadership, and the Holy Spirit. These three keys renew us and finally take us in the direction Jesus means for us to go as his disciples in 2023.

We will invite priests and their leadership from the region around us and the dioceses of Altoona-Johnstown, Greensburg, Pittsburgh, Harrisburg, and Baltimore, which border us on the south. And, if we invite all these people from all these dioceses, we will need your help. We are to be the hosts. It will be a big day for us. So, please save the date. If you can, clear your calendar, and we will share more later. Of course, the Bishop will be here too. We will keep you posted very soon.

#### **EUCHARISTIC REVIVAL: DID YOU KNOW?**

The Eucharist is not just a sacrament; it is the "source and summit" of the Catholic Church. According to the Catechism, a sacrament is "an outward <u>sign</u>, instituted by <u>Christ</u>, to give <u>grace</u>," hence the Eucharist being the most blessed of all sacraments. The Catechism also states: "In the most blessed sacrament of the Eucharist,' the body and blood, together with the soul and divinity of our Lord Jesus Christ, therefore, the whole Christ is truly, really, and substantially contained. This presence is called 'real.'" (CCC1374)

#### **OMOS Assistance Ministry Activity Report for 2022**

Thanks to our generous parish family, we helped 425 families in the past year with much-needed assistance. Poverty in our area is staggering. Cambria County is listed as the poorest county in Pennsylvania. Many live on \$750 monthly and pay for rent, utilities, transportation, and necessities. Moms struggle without child support, the "working poor" cannot exist on their pathetic income, and one unexpected expense can put any of them into severe financial trouble. These are among the families we help. We care deeply about the mission of the Ministry. We thank you for your incredible generosity and for continuing to bless families in need.
