has turned the night into day!

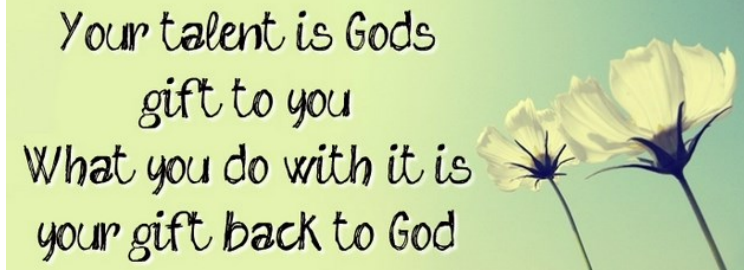
2. We are sons of the morning; we are daughters of day.
