

**Communion: One Love Released**

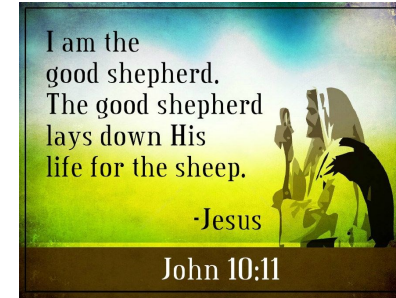
**Refrain:** One bread, one body, one cup, one call,
