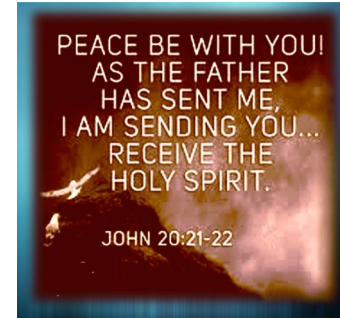
3. Grain for the fields, scattered and grown,
