who hunger for this feast; shelter them with peace.

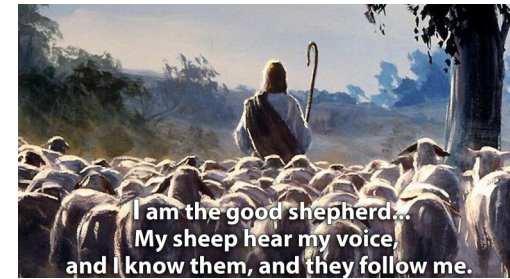
4. Lord of all, give us light.

Gloria (Mass of Creation)

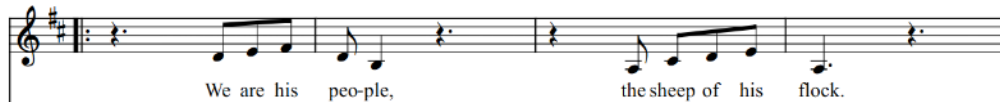
Refrain: Glory to God in the highest and on earth
